

## **Independent Accountants' Report**

I observed the Superbowl on the evening of February 3, 2008 between the Giants of New York and the Patriots of New England in order to determine how many times the word "Payton" was used during the official game in accordance with the rules as posted on [www.richardvining.com](http://www.richardvining.com) as requested. Fox Sports management is responsible for the content and commentary of the game. My responsibility is to express an opinion based on my observation and comprehension of the commentary.

My examination was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and, accordingly, included examining evidence supporting the number of times that "Payton" was used in accordance the aforementioned rules and performing such other procedures as I considered necessary in the circumstances. I believe that my examination provides a reasonable basis for my opinion.

My examination discloses that excessive celebratory gestures by other parties in attendance at said observation could have, individually or in the aggregate, resulted in a material misstatement or deviation from the actual results.

In my opinion, except for the potential material misstatement described in the preceding paragraph, the word "Payton" was used five (5) times, in all material respects in accordance with the rules as set forth on [www.richardvining.com](http://www.richardvining.com),
